Centrelink: Covid-19 Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment

If you or someone you know has been affected by COVID-19, the payment you may be able to get depends on your situation. The eligibility rules are different for each payment. If you're in a COVID-19 hotspot, lockdown or period of restricted movement you may be able to get the COVID-19 Disaster Payment if:

- You had paid employment and because you were in the COVID-19 hotspot or are subject to restricted movement you can't attend work.
- You don't have any appropriate paid leave entitlements.
- You aren't getting Pandemic Leave Disaster Payment, Dad and Partner Pay or Parental Leave Pay.
- You live in, work from or have visited a Commonwealth – declared COVID-19 hotspot.
- You have been told to quarantine or isolate or are caring for someone with COVID-19.

Check your eligibility at <https://www.servicesaustralia.gov.au/individuals/subjects/getting-help-during-coronavirus-covid-19>. The website advises that the best way to claim is to call them on 180 22 66.
